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All the Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education, District Vocational Education Officers, & Principals of Government / Aided / Un-Aided Junior Colleges in the state in which Vocational Health & Paramedical Courses are functioning are informed that the following courses are facilitated "Clinical Attachment" & "Clinical Training" vide orders issued by the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (APVVP) and the Director, Medical Education under references 3 & 5 read above.

- 1) Multipurpose Health Worker (Female) [MPHW(F)]
- 2) Medical Lab Technician (MLT)
- 3) Physiotherapy (PT)
- 4) X-Ray Technician (X-RT)
- 5) Ophthalmic Technician (OT)
- 6) Dental Technician (DT)
- 7) Dental Hygienist (DH).

The Clinical Attachment is facilitated for Regular Intermediate Paramedical Students during the Course period. The Regular Students of MPHW (F) course have to undergo Practical Training for six (6) months in 1st year & Six (6) months in 2nd year Intermediate Course. The Regular Students of Intermediate 1st year MPHW (F) Course have to undergo Clinical Experience at different Hospitals like District Hospitals (DHs), Area Hospitals (AHs) and Community Health Centers (CHCs), and at wards & Out Patient Departments like ENT OP, Eye OP& FP OP etc., for 3 months and field experience at Primary Health Centers (PHCs) for 3 months within the duration of the six months of training in 1st year Intermediate Course. The Regular Students of Intermediate 2nd year MPHW (F) Course have to undergo clinical experience for 3 months at District Hospitals, Area Hospitals, Community Health Centers, Maternity Health & Paediatric (Child) Hospitals and require Clinical experience at wards & outpatient departments like Antenatal OP, Gynaec OP, & Postnatal OP etc. They need to undergo field experience at Primary Health Centers (PHCs) for 3 months within the duration of 6 months of training period of clinical attachment. Rest of the Six (6) courses are facilitated for 6 months of practical training in 1st year and 6 months of practical training in 2nd year course.

The period of the 'On-the Job Training' (OJT) of one month duration can be made an integral part of clinical attachment in 1st and 2nd year Health & Paramedical Courses.

The two-year Intermediate Vocational Paramedical Course completed students i.e. passouts prior to the year 2008 are allowed for "Clinical Training" for the period of one year in all the Hospitals under Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (APVVP) and Teaching Hospitals under Director, Medical Education.

The Department is providing the list of tie-up arrangements between the Junior Colleges and Hospitals which are placed in the Website **www.cie.ap.gov.in.** The Junior Colleges which are attached to the Hospitals were listed course wise and District wise in the Annexure. The Managements under which the Hospitals are functioning are also given to approach further. The Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education, District Vocational Education Officers can download the said information. The teaching Hospitals which will facilitate Clinical training & Clinical attachment under the Director, Medical Education (DME) [in addition to the tie-up arrangements] are also listed under Appendix-1.

All the passouts prior to the year 2008 may approach the concerned District Vocational Education Officer for forwarding their applications to the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (APVVP) through concerned District Coordinators of Hospital Services (DCHS) and Superintendents of Teaching Hospitals under Director, Medical Education (DME). All the Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education, District Vocational Education Officers have to give wide publicity in local newspapers and TV channels about the facility of one year clinical Training in all the Hospitals under the

control of the Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (APVVP) and Teaching Hospitals under the Director, Medical Education (DME).

The Regular students studying in the academic year 2008-2009 have to pay Rs.500/-(Rupees Five Hundred only) in 1st year and Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) in 2nd year Intermediate towards the fee for clinical attachment. The Passouts prior to the year 2008 have to pay Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) towards the fee for Clinical Training for One Year. All the Principals of the Junior Colleges which are attached to the Hospitals under Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad (APVVP) are directed to address the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parish (APVVP), Koti, Hyderabad to permit their trainees for clinical attachment by the mentioning the period / months of training i.e. 6 months in 1st year and 6 months in 2nd year with fee particulars i.e. Rs.500/- in 1st year and Rs.500/- in 2nd year through the concerned District Coordinators of Hospital Services (DCHS) as per the orders of the Commissioner, Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parish (APVVP).

The Principals of the Junior Colleges which are attached to the Hospitals under the control of the Director, Medical Education (DME) are directed to address the Superintendents of the concerned Teaching Hospitals for payment of clinical attachment fee i.e. Rs.500/- in 1st year & Rs.500/- in 2nd year as per the G.O.Ms.No.258, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (K2) Department, Dated 20.08.2004.

All the concerned officers are requested to take necessary action for immediate implementation.
