Sub: - APSAHPC – Clinical Training – Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) and Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLS) students undergoing clinical attachment in Government Teaching General Hospitals – One (1) month clinical training at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) / Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHCs) as part of prescribed clinical training – Instructions – Issued.

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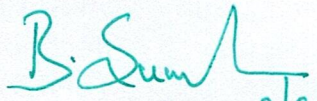
It is informed that, as per the instructions issued by the Director of Medical Education vide reference cited above, Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) and B.Sc. (MLT) students undergoing clinical attachment in the institutions under the control of Director of Medical Education (Government Teaching General Hospitals) shall undergo one (1) month clinical training at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and Urban PHCs, as part of their prescribed 6/12 months clinical training, through the District Medical and Health Officers.

Accordingly, all the Superintendents of Government Teaching General Hospitals in the State of Andhra Pradesh are hereby requested to take necessary action for deputing the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) students undergoing clinical attachment in their respective institutions to the PHCs/UPHCs for a period of one (1) month in coordination with the concerned District Medical and Health Officers (DMHOs).

The students shall undergo the prescribed clinical training under the supervision and guidance of the Medical Officer of the concerned PHC/UPHC and shall maintain regular attendance and discipline during the training period. The Medical Officer of the concerned PHC/UPHC shall ensure that the students are provided appropriate clinical exposure and training in accordance with the requirements of their course.

On successful completion of the one-month clinical training, the Medical Officer of the concerned PHC/UPHC shall issue a Training Certificate to each student, clearly mentioning the name of the student, course, period of training and satisfactory completion of the prescribed training and the concerned Superintendent of the Government Teaching General Hospital shall maintain proper records relating to the deputation/allotment of students, period of training, attendance and completion of clinical training.

Proper records of student allotment, attendance, clinical training and certificates issued shall also be maintained by the concerned institution and produced before the Council/competent authority whenever required.

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In pursuance of the instructions issued in the reference cited, it is decided that the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology and B.Sc. (MLT) students undergoing clinical attachment in the institutions under the control of the Director of Medical Education and other institutions shall undergo one (1) month clinical training at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) & Urban PHCs as a part of clinical training of 6 months/12 months, through the District Medical and Health Officers under the control of the Director of Public Health and Family Welfare.

Further, it is instructed that every student shall submit the training certificate issued by the Medical Officer of the concerned PHC/UPHC and the Superintendent of the concerned institution at the time of registration/issue of the course certificate.

The Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P., Vijayawada, and the Secretary, Andhra Pradesh State Allied Healthcare Professional Council, A.P., Vijayawada, are requested to issue the course certificate only on submission of the training certificate issued by the Medical Officer of the concerned PHC and the Superintendent of the concerned institution.

The Director of Public Health and Family Welfare, A.P., Vijayawada, is requested to issue necessary instructions to the District Medical and Health Officers to allot the students for clinical training at the Primary Health Centres/UPHCs for a period of one month and to ensure that the training certificates are issued by the concerned Medical Officers.
