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In continuation of the APSAHPC Circular 3rd cited, wherein applications were invited for alignment of intake capacity for institutions offering Allied and Healthcare Diploma and Bachelor Degree Courses in accordance with the NCAHP-approved Competency-Based Curricula, it is hereby informed that the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP) has subsequently released the Competency-Based Curriculum for Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) prescribing the programme structure, minimum standard requirements, infrastructure, faculty, laboratories, clinical attachment requirements and approved intake capacity.

Accordingly, all existing institutions conducting the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) course whose sanctioned intake capacity is not in conformity with the intake prescribed under the NCAHP-approved curriculum shall apply to the Andhra Pradesh State Allied and Healthcare Professions Council (APSAHPC) for alignment of intake capacity.

The applications shall be considered subject to fulfilment of the Minimum Standard Requirements prescribed in the NCAHP Competency-Based Curriculum for DMLT.

Therefore, all eligible institutions seeking alignment of intake capacity for the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) course shall submit the Representation/Request addressed to the APSAHP Council.
